

Holster Safety (auto pistol)

A lot of shooting ranges across the country have started to ban holsters because of Negligent Discharge. We encourage everyone to take weapons training. If you haven't yet, we hope these simple guidelines will keep you safe until then.

By following these simple rules, you can avoid being a statistic yourself.



#1 Before playing with live ammo, please remember these simple rules.



#2 Since we always treat every gun like it is loaded, never point it at anything you do not wish to destroy.



#3 When holstering your weapon, "LOOK" and be sure there isn't anything in your holster.



#4 Once you have verified that your holster is clear, insert your handgun with your thumb on the back of the slide. This will insure that your weapon does not go out of battery, especially if you have a strong retention holster.



#5 When drawing your weapon, "ALWAYS" keep your finger straight and off the trigger.
